Good Afternoon Cheryl,

From 11:59pm on 21 June, indoor physical recreation venues can open with up to 20 people allowed per separate enclosed space. This is subject to the four square metre rule, with up to 10 people per group or activity.

I am pleased to confirm that subject to club compliance with requirements and advice from the Victorian Chief Health Officer, Council supports resumption of indoor activities at Coulson Pavilion from Monday 22 June.

Prior to this each club needs to complete a [Return to Play Plan](#) using the SRV template and submit Yarra's [Return to Play Survey](#). The attached *Conditions of Hire* provides further instructions. You can also refer to previous 'Return to Play' emails or let me know if they need to be resent.

The Society of Creative Anachronism is classified as a community recreation therefore does need to complete the plan, although some of the questions won't be applicable.

Any questions let us know, otherwise we look forward to receiving the documentation and getting everyone back in action very soon.

5.5 Knight Marshal – Magnus

At the moment we are still unable to conduct in person training.

I have been posting weekly fighting post to Facebook. As most of the content is on Facebook I have not been clogging the list with the posts.

Working on setting up an intro to heavy combat/fundamental skill/structured training for when training can return to Coulson reserve.

Missive below from KEM in relation to extension of authorisation due to current situation.

Grace period for authorisations:

Greetings to the combatants and marshals of the kingdom!

We have endured some dark times over the past few months, and that may continue for some parts of the kingdom, but with the solstice comes a return of the light, and the promise of a return to our joyful pastimes of killing our friends for fun.

During the restrictions we have not been able to run authorisations, so I issued an extension on any authorisations which expired after the 13th of March 2020. This extension will continue in Australia until 2 months after restrictions on relevant activities lift (either by SCA Ltd Australia or mundane authorities, whichever is later) in your area, or 3 months after for equestrian activities.

These dates may end up varying across the states, and I encourage event stewards and the marshals in charge of events to make time in event schedules for running authorisations ahead of major tournaments of any discipline.

For the Crescent Isles, since we can have events and activities as normal already, the two month period starts today. Any authorisation with an expiry date between 13 March 2020 and 21 August 2020 will be considered valid until the 21st of August 2020, or 21 September 2020 for equestrian authorisations.

Authorising marshals of all kinds, your role in making sure that your own authorisations are renewed in a timely manner is particularly important, as when your group runs out of the ability to make new marshals, it's a bit of a problem!
