2.30 pm - Kingdom A&S competition

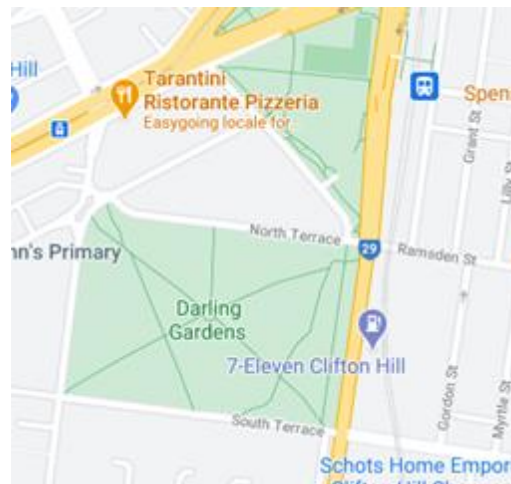
3.30pm – Closing court

It is proposed to hold the event at Darling Gardens, a small park in Clifton Hill within walking distance to a train station and parking available around the park.
